that amount \$2,911.18, leaving a balance of \$1,782.79 worth of free work done by the Hospital from its earnings. More than 160 persons have thus received free treatment during this year.

For some time past the Hospital has been taxed to its capacity. The daily average of patients now is more than double that of a year ago. The staff of physicians is composed of specialists in medical science and surgical skill. The writer is personally acquainted with the chairman, Dr. McIntosh, and does not hesitate to recommend him as worthy of the high position he occupies. In the chapel every morning before breakfast, a portion of the Bible is read and prayer is offered to God for guidance and blessing. Medical science, surgical skill and prayer certainly make a good combination, especially in such buildings and with such charges as a patient can get at the South Carolina Baptist Hospital, Columbia, S. C.

We therefore recommend:

1. That patients able to pay for treatment patronize this hospital.
2. That churches able to do so co-operate with the Hospital by paying the expenses of treatment for their members who need treatment at a hospital and are not able to pay for it.
3. That ministers, deacons, churches and all persons whomsoever refrain from recommending for free treatment any person who is able to pay for treatment.
4. That contributions to aid the Hospital in giving free treatment to persons needing treatment at a hospital, but not able to pay for it, be sent to Rev. Louis J. Bristow, Superintendent, Columbia, S. C.
