versity and also of the Seminary at Louisville, Ky. He was pastor at Four Holes and Cameron and no pastor was more beloved by his own people than he. Brother Reed had a rare gift of making friends, and the great throng attending his funeral at Bull Swamp attested the general esteem in which he was held by all classes. At Four Holes under his wise leadership was erected one of the best arranged and most serviceable country church houses in the State. He leaves a wife and two bright children. Mrs. Reed was the efficient and honored leader of the Missionary Societies of Orangeburg Association. G. Byron Reed, Jr., was young, full of enthusiasm, with a splendid tact for leadership and is much missed in our meetings, and his place in our hearts and the work of the Master will be hard to fill.

Robert H. Jones a member of North church and cashier of Bank of North for a number of years, and useful patriotic citizen, was a victim of influenza.

Grover K. Jeffcoat, a member of the church at North and loyal to work of church, another victim of influenza.
