#### Tribute of Respect to F. L. Ulmer.

A Prince in Israel has fallen after having fought under the banner of Christ for over half a century. A good man is gone from us. He was a good father, citizen, and a consecrated church worker. He was a Consistent member of the Four Holes Baptist Church in the Orangeburg Association. He fell to his rest on June the 10th, 1923 in his 75th year. He leaves three children and a host of friends to mourn his departure. His living children are as follows:—Mr. S. F. Ulmer, Mr. W. E. Ulmer, and Mrs. Maggie Shuler. His wife and three children having preceded him to the glory world by several years.

He was a Confederate soldier in the war between the states. Having volunteered in October 1864 to fight for that which he felt was right. He enlisted in Company F. of the Second Regiment of South Carolina Infantry under Captain Avinger. He served in that command until the close of the war. He was honorably discharged from the service at Spartanburg South Carolina in April 1865.

1. That the men's Baraca Class of Four Holes Baptist Sunday School has lost a faithful member. One who was true in service for God.

2. That the Church has lost a true soldier of the Cross. One who was always ready to obey the marching orders of the King.
