user, Superintendent of Sunday School Work, Director of Training Union Work, ten members of the Executive Committee, a Promotion Committee, and a Finance Committee.

1. Necessity temporary committees (such as Time, Place and Preacher and Resolutions) to report during the session of the Association, shall be appointed by the Moderator.
2. The Moderator shall appoint Standing Committees to make reports on the progress and needs of the various agencies and work of our Denomination. Such reports to be presented at the succeeding annual meeting.
3. Such Special Committees as may be found necessary for the proper functioning of the Association during its sessions shall be appointed by the Moderator.
4. Only one person shall speak at a time, and that will be after he has secured permission from the Moderator. No one shall speak more than twice on the same subject without permission of the Association.
5. No member shall be interrupted while speaking unless he departs from the subject or uses personalities.
6. Every motion taken up by the body shall be decided or withdrawn before another is received; but motions to adjourn, to lay on t. o. e. to strike out, to postpone, to recommit, to amend, or a substitute motion, shall always be in order.
7. The Moderator shall have the same privilege of speech as any other member, provided he calls some other member to the chair while he is speaking. He shall have no vote unless the Association is equally divided.
8. Any of the By-Laws may be altered, or amended, during any regular meeting of the Association by a two-thirds vote of the members present.
